

HKBU recently set up Hong Kong's largest Normobaric Hypoxic Chamber in its Dr. Stephen Hui Research Centre for Physical Recreation and Wellness (CPRW) to further promote the development of hypoxia-related research. On 28 January 2014, Prof. Frank Fu, Associate Vice-President and Director of CPRW and his team released the findings of a research project entitled "The effects of maximal intermittent exercises in normoxia and hypoxia environments on the release of cardiac biomarkers and the potential mechanism" and introduced the current and upcoming research projects and the future consultancy services of the Chamber to the general public.

Two HKBU scholars have received the 2013 State Natural Science Award (Second Class) for their outstanding research projects in the field of natural sciences. Prof. Raymond Wong Wai-yeung, Associate Head and Chair Professor of the Department of Chemistry, who leads a research team, was awarded for the project entitled "Multifunctional Metallopolymers/Metallophosphors and Their Emerging Applications". Prof. Zhu Lixing, Head and Chair Professor of the Department of Mathematics was awarded for his project entitled "Model Checking and Dimension Reduction in Regression".

Prof. Adrian Bailey Named Academician of Academy of Social Sciences of UK 且力行教授獲英國社會科學院頒授院士榮銜



Prof. Adrian Bailey 貝力行教授 The Academy of Social Sciences, UK, has conferred the award of Academician on Prof. Adrian Bailey, Dean of Social Sciences, in recognition of his outstanding achievement in social sciences research and his impact on advancing social sciences. Currently, the Academy has around 87,000 memberships from its 45 learned societies and only just over 1 % of the members are named Academicians who are entitled to use the letters "AcSS" after their name. Prof. Bailey is one of the two scholars in Hong Kong on whom the honour was bestowed.



HKBU Scholar Develops New Nanoshell-based Composite for Hepatic Tumour Chemoembolisation Surgery and Magnetic Resonance Imaging

浸大學者及團隊研發新型納米殼複合材料可用於肝腫瘤化療栓塞微創手術和磁力共振造影

Dr. Ken Leung, Assistant Professor of the Department of Chemistry at HKBU, together with experts from the radiology departments of The Chinese University of Hong Kong and Central South University of China, developed a novel self-assembled composite which enables intra-arterial embolisation of liver tumour blood vessels followed by slow and sustained drug release of anticancer drug which offers a therapeutic advantage. The results can be applied to increase the efficacy of transcatheter hepatic arterial chemoembolisation and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI).

浸大化學系助理教授梁湛輝博士,聯同香港中文大學及中國中南大學的放射學專家合作研發 一項新型的自組裝複合物,該複合材料能持續、緩慢地釋放抗癌藥物,栓塞為肝腫瘤供血的 動脈,達到治療效果。研究成果可應用於提升肝腫瘤化療栓塞微創手術的功效和用於磁力 共振造影。
